 - Social Science: ACCT (324, 437, 439, 504); AFRO; BADM; COLA; CRJU; ECON; FINA; GEOG (except 201, 202, 545, 546); HIST; IBUS; LASP; MGMT; MGSC (except 290 and 291); MKTG; POLI; SOST; WOST.
 - Behavioral Science: anthropology, psychology, sociology. No statistics or computer courses in this area.
 - Natural Science: astronomy, biology, chemistry, environment, geology, 4-hour geography (201,202,545,546), marine science, & physics.
 - Options: Another STAT, or MATH 122, or MATH 141 or PHIL 110 and 111, or CSCE 101 and 102
 - Additional CSCE, CLIS 529, MATH, STAT, science, logic, some accounting, and some foreign language courses.
