- 1) **English: (15 hours)** ENGL 101 & 102 must have "C" or higher grades.
 * ENGL 283, 288, 289 (283 recommended)
 ** ENGL 285, 287 (285 recommended)
 *** ENGL 460, 462-465; 600-605
- 2) **Fine Arts: (6 hours)** courses in the history or appreciation of art (ARTE), music (MUSC), theater (THEA), and dance (DANC); also includes art history (ARTH), classic studies (CLAS), religious studies (RELG), and most philosophy (PHIL) (not logic). No performance courses may be used. See student handbook for full listing of "fine arts" courses.
Humanities or English: (3 hours) any other humanities (Fine Art) or English course that is not already required. See student handbook for full list.
- 3) **Social Science: (24 hours)** African-American studies, business administration, economics, 3-hour geography, history, Latin American Studies, political science, Southern, and Women studies. See handbook for specific restrictions.
 *Social Science 300+level Non-US, Non-Western European HIST or POLI. See handbook for complete list.
 **Social Sci elct: Any other social science course not already required.
- 4) **Behavioral Science: (6 hours)** anthropology, psychology, sociology. No statistics or computer courses in this area.
- 5) **Natural Science: (7-8 hours)** astronomy, biology, chemistry, environment, geology, 4-hour geography (201,202,545,546), marine science, & physics.
- 6) **Analytical Reasoning: (6-9 hours)** Another STAT, or MATH 122, or MATH 141 or PHIL 110 & 111, or CSCE 101 & 102
- 7) **Sci/Reas/Lang: (1-5 hours)** Additional CSCE, MATH, STAT, science, logic, accounting, and some foreign language courses. See handbook for full list. [Natural Science, Analytical Reasoning, and Sci/Reas/Lang hours must total a minimum of 18 hours.]
- 8) **Minor:** The minor must be approved and on file in the Student Services Office no later than the end of the freshman year (30 hours). Students without approved minors on file might experience delays in progression and/or graduation. Check the 2004-2005 student handbook for complete instructions.
- 9) **Journalism Elective: (9 hours)** Any JOUR course that is not already required by the Print Curriculum. It is recommended, but not required, that you take JOUR 548 (Internship).
