- 3. Social Science: ACCT (324, 437, 439, 504); AFRO; BADM; COLA; CRJU; ECON; FINA; GEOG (except 201, 202, 545, 546); HIST; IBUS; LASP; MGMT; MGSC (except 290 and 291); MKTG; POLI; SOST; WOST.
- 4. Behavioral Science: Anthropology, Psychology, and/or Sociology. No Statistics or Computer courses in this area.
- 5. Natural Science: Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Studies, Geology, **4-hour Geography (201,202,545,546)**, Marine Science, or Physics.
- 6. Options: Another Stat, or Math 122, or Math 141 or Phil 110 and 111, or Csce 101 and 102
- 7. Additional Csce, Slis 529, Math, Stat, Science, Logic, **some** Accounting, and **some** Foreign Language courses.
- 8. Minor: Must be approved & on file in the Student Services no later than the end of the freshman year. Students without approved minors on file might experience delays in progression and/or graduation.
