

# **MEDIA GENERAL MULTI-MEDIA PART-TIME INTERNSHIPS FOR FALL AND SPRING**

Eligible students include undergraduate majors, preferably juniors and seniors who have the ability to shoot, write, and edit content for multiple clients that include a community newspaper, television stations and interactive media. The primary focus will be legislative and public affairs news and information; the intern will also be expected to provide USC sports coverage, local issues, digital photography and web content on State Government, the Court System, etc.

Interns will work 10-12 hours per week during the semester and will receive compensation in the form of tuition reimbursement (for three academic credits.) Two interns will be selected, one for each semester, and will be located in Columbia.

To apply: complete the application form and return it with resume, cover letter and five newspaper clips or other writing samples. Tapes, CD's or links to web sites on which the applicant has worked may also be submitted, but the writing samples are required. The application process includes letters of recommendation from SJMC faculty advisors.
