POST-GRADUATE INTERNSHIP

Eligible students include recent graduates who have the ability to shoot, write, and edit content for multiple clients that include a community newspaper, television stations and interactive media. The primary focus will be legislative and public affairs news and information; the intern will also be expected to provide USC sports coverage, local issues, digital photography and web content on State Government, the Court System, etc. The position is for 9 months and will be located in Columbia. The post-graduate intern may be eligible for full-time employment upon completion of the internship period.

To apply: complete the application form and return it with resume, cover letter and five newspaper clips or other writing samples. Tapes, CD's or links to web sites on which the applicant has worked may also be submitted, but the writing samples are required. The application process includes letters of recommendation from SJMC faculty advisors.
